THE BIG SUFFOLK PRAYER WALK

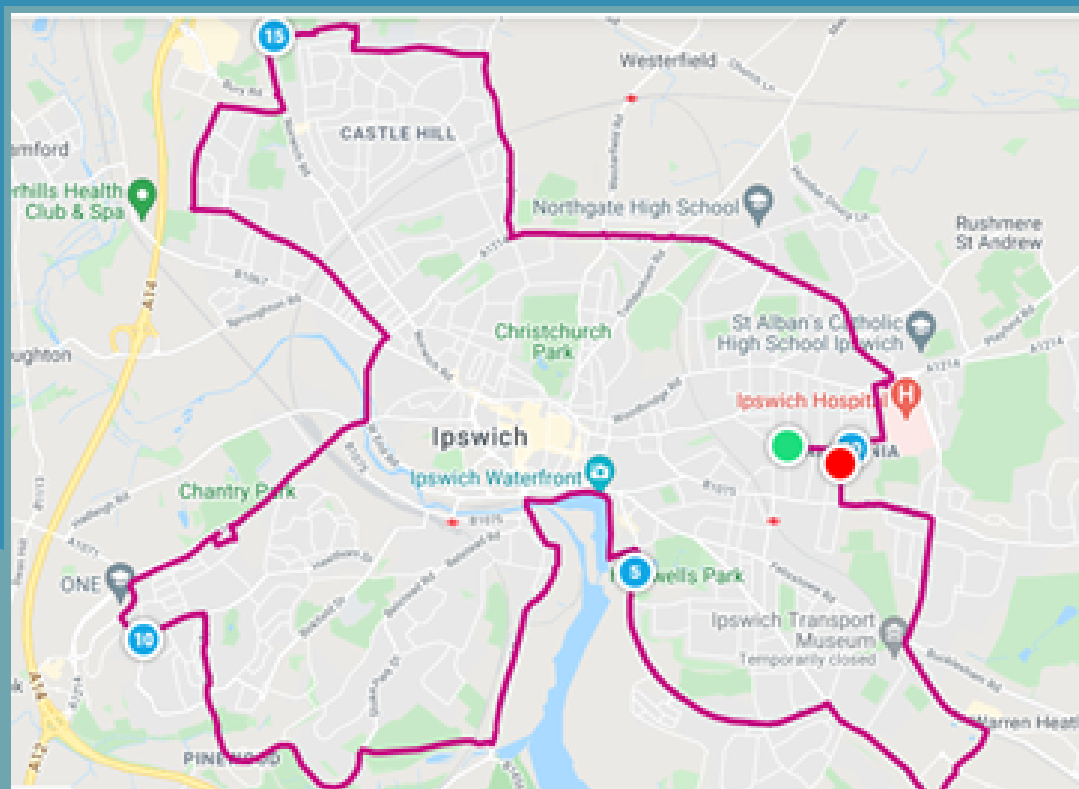


Last year a team of people walked the Ipswich town boundary route, with stopping points along the way for people to join in for all or parts of the walk.

This year, although an organised walk is not going ahead, we'd still love to encourage people to walk along the same routes, praying for the town of Ipswich.

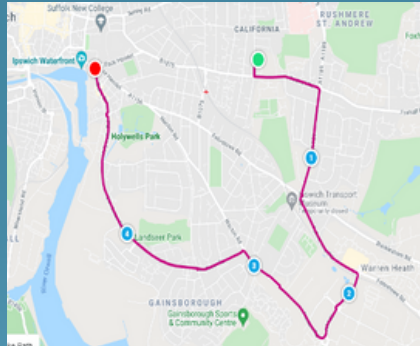
The full map of the boundary is highlighted below, but on the following page you can find shorter sections of the map that you may want to try.

The route is just under 21 miles in total and last year took the team around 8 hours to complete.



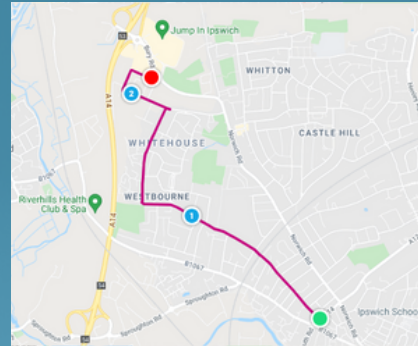
Boundary Walk Shorter Routes

Stage One. St Andrews to University (5 miles approx.)



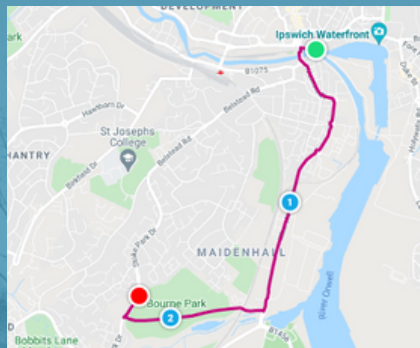

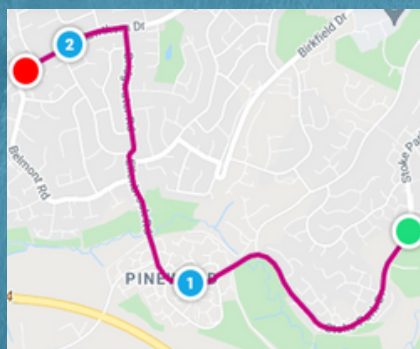
